Useful Umbrella Cord

It was a rainy day, it stopped raining and I had a wet Umbrella and my hands where full, and this appeared on my cable needles when I got home ;0)

(2) 4mm cable dpns, (I like using cable needles, they're nice and short) and sturdy Dk yarn Cast on 4 st using the loop method, Icord for 2"

Pick-up 4 st from the cast in row, K2tog for to bring the 8st together 1st from each end of the work to bring count back to 4st. (this should make a tight little loop)



Continue Icording these remaining 4st for 40" (or desired length) Place a marker through the 4st continuing to Icord for another 4" then graft the 4st to the 4st on the marker, darn in ends and bury the tail in the cord. Enjoy!
